Introduction of electric powered equipment

To support quiet study periods, OUTCO have introduced a fleet of battery powered tools and vehicles to reduce noise levels in order not to disturb student learning. We are proud to introduce electric vehicles and tools into our fleet and embrace new technologies as we strive to become carbon neutral / carbon zero.

In addition to battery powered equipment, we have built flexibility into our work schedules to accommodate "quiet periods" where no engine powered equipment is used at all.

Practical student support

Working with students studying environmental courses, OUTCO has brought their theoretical studies to fruition and implemented many of the findings from their biodiversity reports.

Hedgehog conservation

As our part in the commitment by the University to create a hedgehog-friendly campus, OUTCO has trained all staff on hedgehog awareness and conservation. All equipment carries hedgehog awareness branding as we support the University and the British Hedgehog Preservation Society in the protection of this vulnerable mammal.
